Syringe services programs are community-based prevention programs that allow people who use drugs to live safer and healthier lives.

Syringe services programs provide free and confidential services. Most programs offer naloxone kits, wound care supplies, referrals to substance use disorder treatment and health care, drug-checking strips, HIV and hepatitis C rapid testing, and other harm reduction tools to people who use drugs and their loved ones.
